New Relationship Trust 2020-2021 First Nations K-12 Education Grant Initiative

K-12 EDUCATION GRANT INITIATIVE

The New Relationship Trust (NRT) Board of Directors has committed to funding BC First Nations to deliver Kindergarten to Grade 12 (K-12) projects for 2020-2021 that are delivered at the community level. K-12 grants provide funding to BC First Nations and First Nations schools to assist in the delivery of educational projects and promote student achievements.

WHO CAN APPLY?

- BC First Nation communities and First Nation schools
- Only one application will be approved per BC First Nation. If a BC First Nation applies for funding, the First Nations school in the same community will not receive funding as well.
- Projects that received K-12 funding from the NRT or the NRT Foundation in the last fiscal year are required to submit their 2019-2020 final report before applying for 2020-2021 funds.

FUNDING AMOUNT

The maximum amount available is \$8,000.00 per BC First Nation or School

FUNDING CRITERIA

- BC First Nations can apply for funding up to \$8,000 for education projects for K-12 students that are in the following related areas: ① **Academic programs**; ② **Indigenous Culture**
- Applications required to have a letter of Support attached from your First Nation's office e.g. *Executive Director, Administrator, Education coordinator, etc* and must on letterhead. If a school is applying a letter from the Education department from the school on letterhead is required.
- A Final Report needs to be submitted once project has been completed or by last day of school June 30, 2021



Examples of Eligible Expenses:

- Education Projects (e.g. reading and literacy workshops, enhancing education through technology, homework clubs with tutors)
- Purchase Education Supplies (e.g. science equipment, text books, educational computer games, etc.)
- Purchasing of iPad, tablets, syncing machines
- Aboriginal Parents as Literacy Supporters (APALS)

Examples of Ineligible Expenses:

- Administrative & Overhead Costs
- Corporate/Business Projects
- Honorariums/Gifting students
- First Nations staff salaries or teachers attending conferences/workshops
- Operating costs for new or previous programs
- **NO Field trips**

FINAL REPORT REQUIREMENTS

Final Report Deadline: Last day of school June 30, 2021.

Funded projects will be required to submit a final report following the completion of the project. When submitting your written final K-12 report, please include the following:

- A project description matching the one in your proposal;
- Description of how many students were involved and affected by the project;
- Description of how the New Relationship Trust was recognized as a K-12 Education Grant sponsor for the project; and
- A complete budget that details how the New Relationship Trust Foundation K-12 Education Grant funds cost to complete.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Grants will be awarded until funds are exhausted.
